How does Vylla protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

### **Notice to Nevada Residents**

#### **Notice to New Mexico Residents**

## **Notice to Vermont Residents**

We will not share your personal information with nonaffiliated third parties, except as permitted by law. We will not share information about your transactions and experiences with our affiliates for their everyday business purposes and to market to you unless permitted by law or unless you give us permission to do so.
